

Each mill is equivalent to \$1 in taxes per \$1,000 of taxable value. If your property is assessed at \$175,000 and your millage rate is 4.79 mill, in 2017 you paid \$838.25 in Township taxes. For 2018, you will pay \$907.38 in Township taxes. The increase of .395 mills is to fund the road projects bond issue taken out in 2016.
